



Aircraft Engine Historical Society Fourteenth Annual Convention

Tucson, Arizona
(Tuesday 3 October - Friday 6 October 2017)

The 2017 AEHS Convention features the Pima Air & Space Museum (PASM) and the Titan Missile Museum (TMM).

The PASM, spread over 80 acres and displays over 300 aircraft. Also on the PASM grounds is the 309th Memorial Museum, with WWII memorabilia, documents and a restored Boeing B-17. Across the street from the PASM is Davis-Monthan Air Force Base and the 309th Aerospace Maintenance and Regeneration Group (AMARG), which manages the world's largest aircraft boneyard. AEHS 2017 Convention registration includes admission to the PASM and the 309th Memorial Museum. Also included is a tour of the PASM restoration facility and a bus tour of the 309th AMARG.

The TMM is based on preserved Titan II missile complex 571-7, which is all that remains of the 54 Titan II missile sites that were on alert across the United States from 1963 until 1987. Launched from its underground silo in just 58 seconds, the Titan II ICBM was capable of delivering a 9-megaton nuclear warhead to targets more than 6,300 miles away in about 30 minutes. This once top-secret place is now a National Historic Landmark.

As always, the AEHS 2017 Convention will include a full day of outstanding presentations covering a wide range of topics. Please don't miss this opportunity to see, hear, learn, and visit with other engine enthusiasts.
